The *Sexposer* application will be available in English and on Android.

Montreal- November 12th, 2014

On World AIDS Day, the Portail VIH/sida du Québec will officially launch the new version of the ***Sexposer*** app for smart phones and tablets.

Free and downloadable already on Apple and from December 1st on Android, ***Sexposer***, is the first mobile application in Quebec for the prevention of HIV and STIs. It allows users to assess their risk of exposure to HIV and STIs through a short quiz, while also using GPS to help locate the nearest testing sites and sexual health resources. Directly from the application, the user can now send additional questions about sexual health by SMS in French and in English via the SextEd project, organized by Aids Community Care Montreal (ACCM).

Sexposer is part of a technological shift in the continued fight against HIV/AIDS and STIs in Quebec. With the resurgence of sexually transmitted infections, particularly among young people (14-25), access to reliable information can make a huge difference.

On December 1st, World AIDS Day, the Portail VIH/sida du Québec recognizes the end of the fundraising campaign dedicated to developing ***Sexposer*** by inviting you to a 5 @ 7. A silkscreen print from the painter Fernand Leduc will be awarded through a draw amongst eligible donors who contributed to the campaign.
